

Nicholas Mann and the I Tatti Library have achieved something very special here. Petrarch's private, secret thoughts are beautifully translated. The "secret book" is written as a dialogue between Franciscus and Augustinus both of whom are "in the presence of a beautiful woman." Lineated Latin text with facing English translation (just like Loeb). Petrarch's Invectives (also available from I Tatti) and his Life of Solitude both argue against a gluttonous, material life; both betray the author's conflicted relationship to life's most superficial and gilded adornments. The true man is here revealed, naked and afraid.
